OTHER INITIATIVES

The school has functional Rain Water harvesting plants in both the wings & Vermi Compost Plant for conservation of Rain Water & production of Compost manure. Fire safety drill was held in the school campus to teach and train the teachers on how to handle fire safety equipment thereby ensuring safety of the students as well as staff and other employees of the school.

FIRE SERVICE WEEK - 15 - 20 APRIL 2022

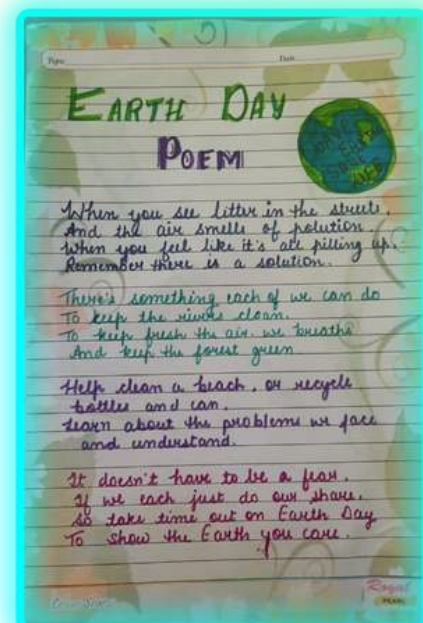
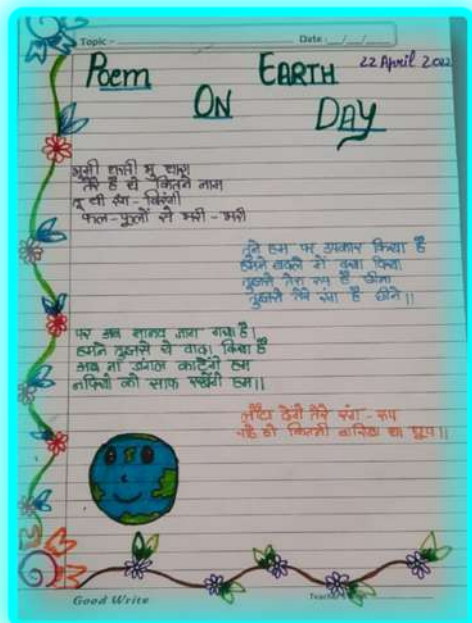

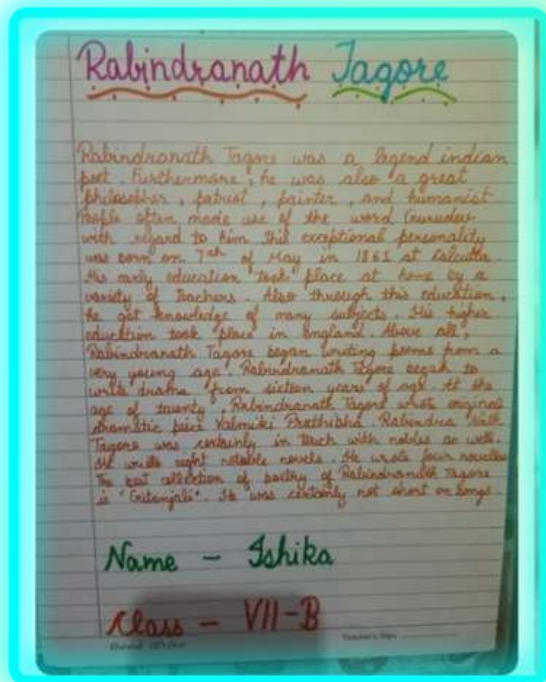
RABINDRANATH TAGORE

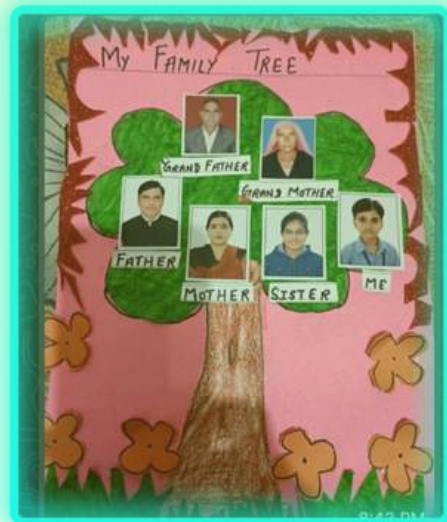
The International Day of Families, annually held on May 15, celebrates the importance of families.

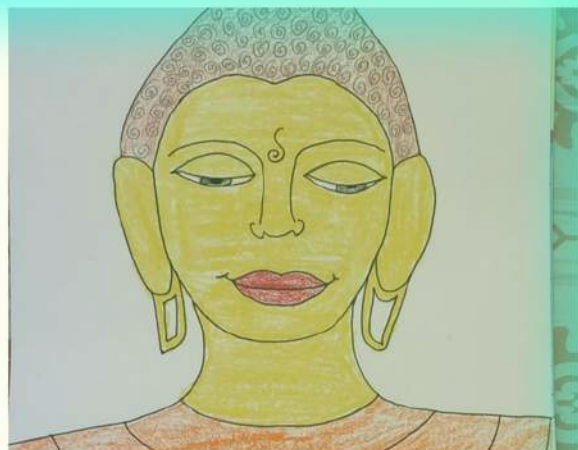
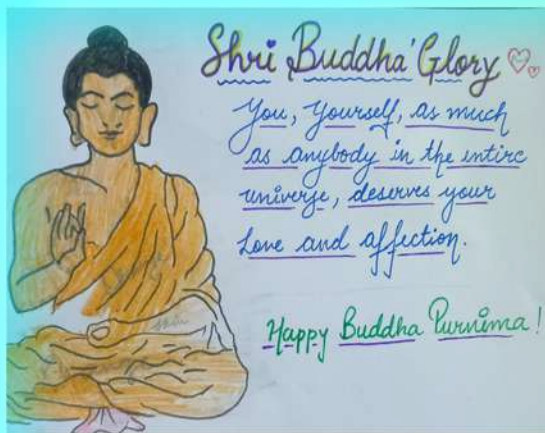




BUDDHA POORNIMA - 16 MAY 2022

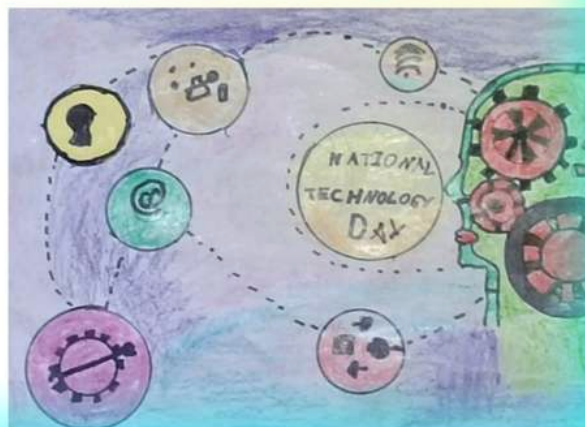
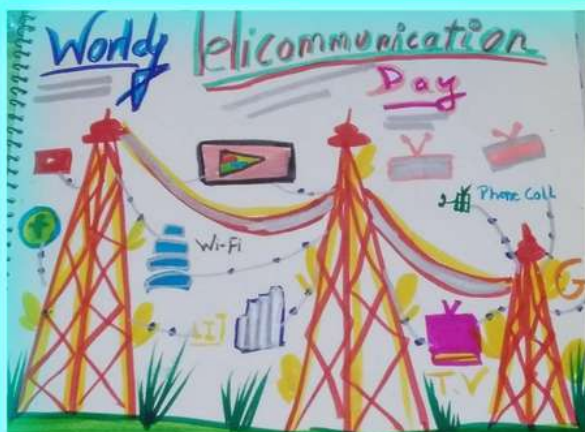




WORLD TELECOMMUNICATION DAY - 17 MAY 2022

"Tobacco companies kill their best customers."

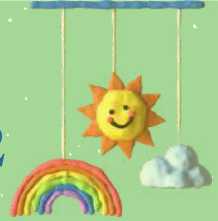

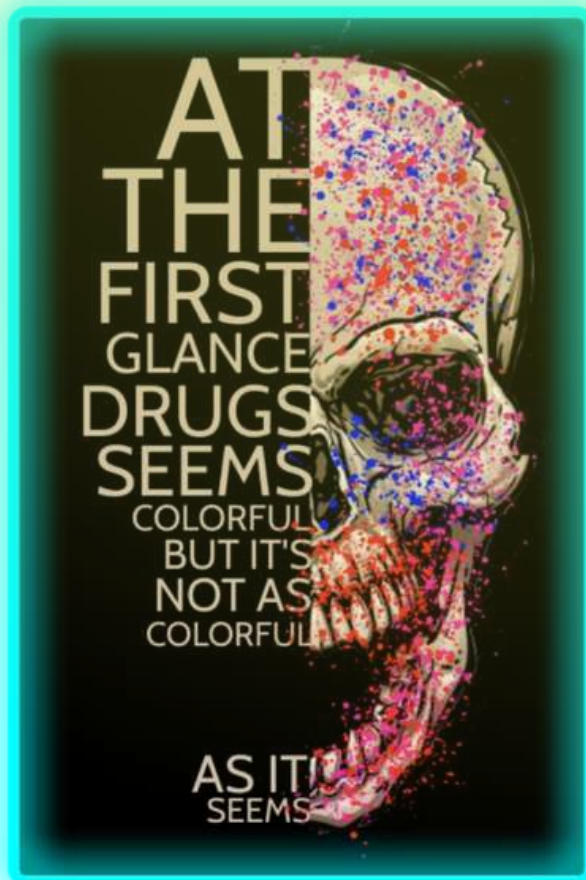
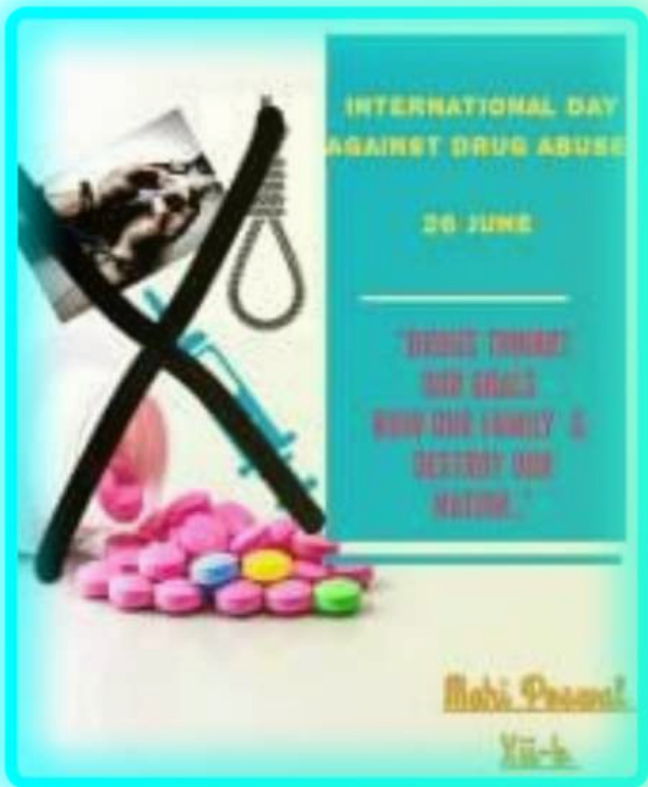
"Drug misuse is not a disease, it is a decision, like the decision to step out in front of a moving car. You would call that not a disease but an error of judgment." - Philip

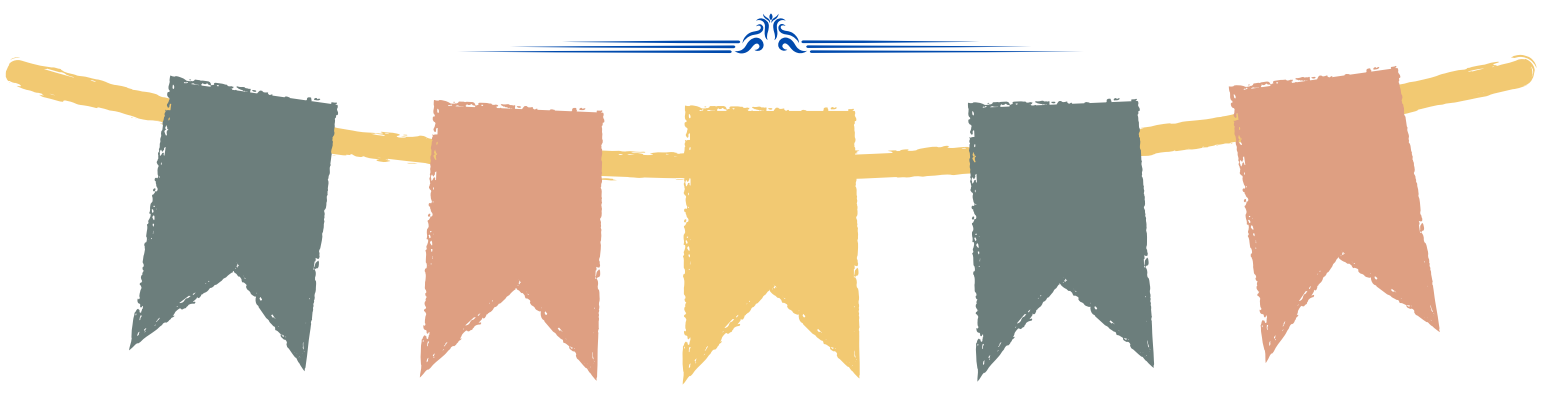

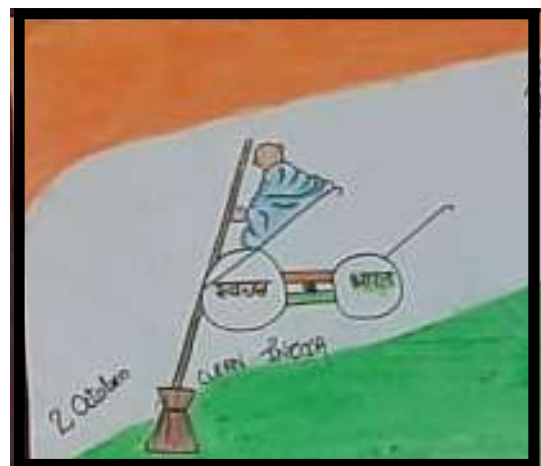
2nd October : Gandhi Jayanti

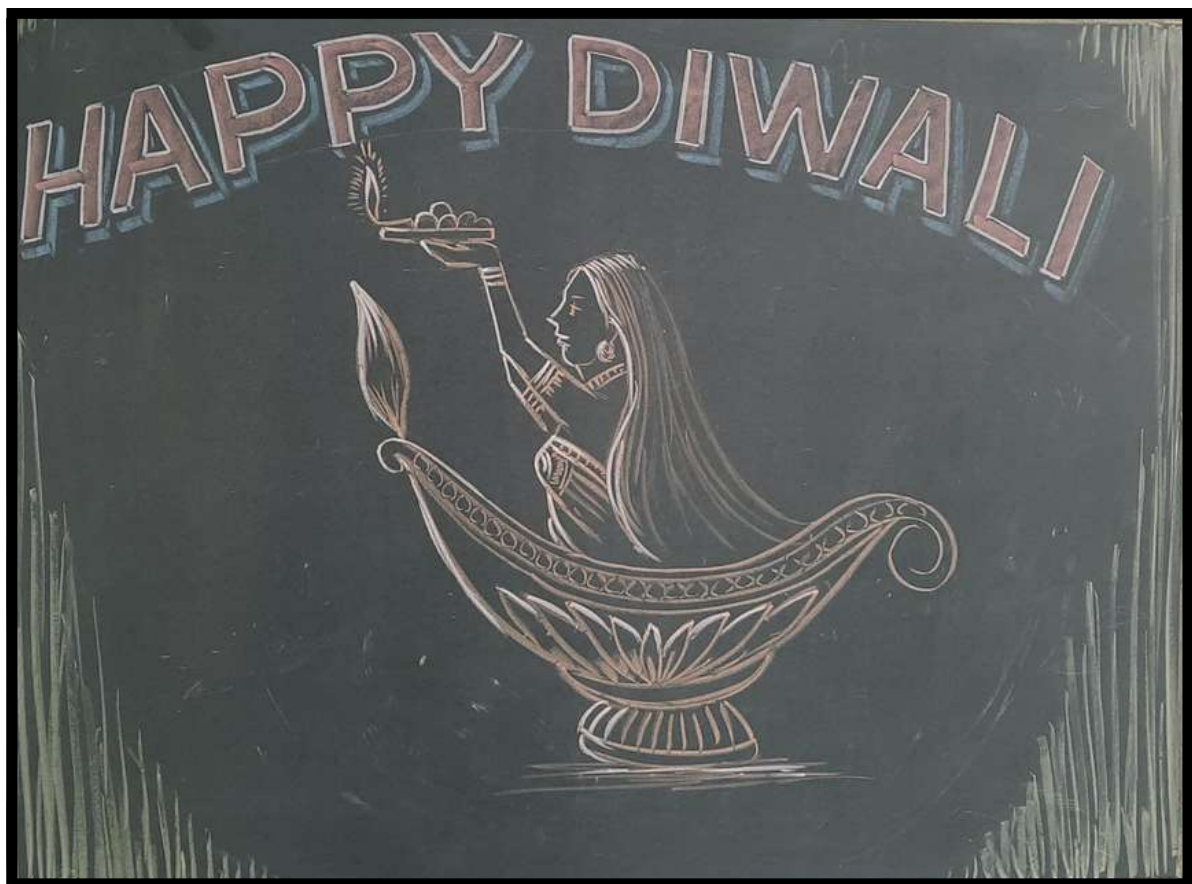
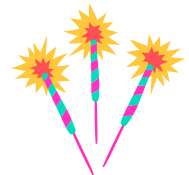
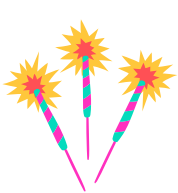


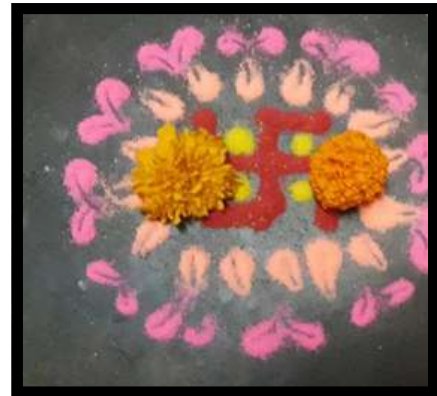
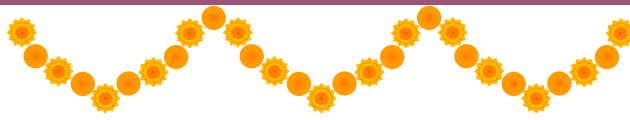
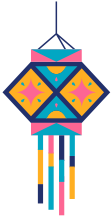
HAPPY DIWALI

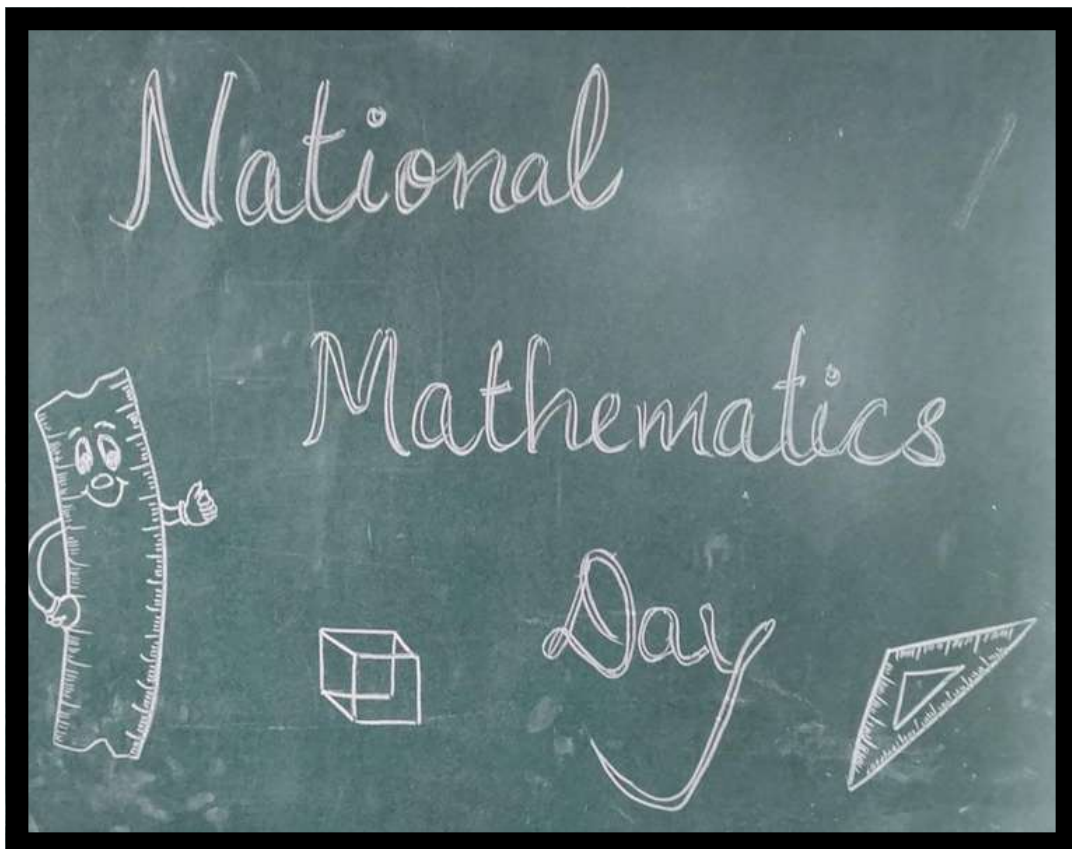


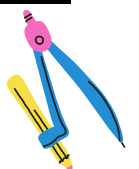
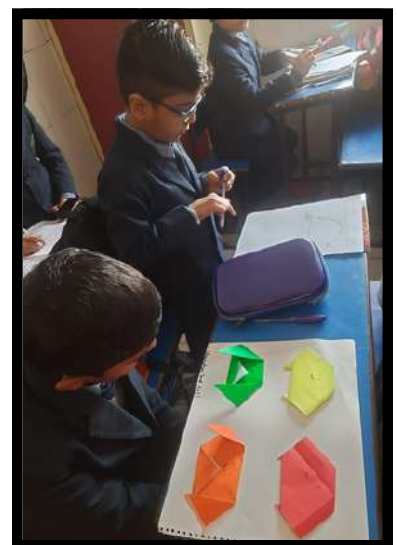
22nd December : Mathematics Day

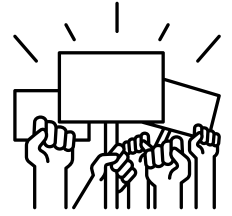
State Level Jawaharlal Nehru Science, Mathematics and Environment Exhibition : 2022-2023

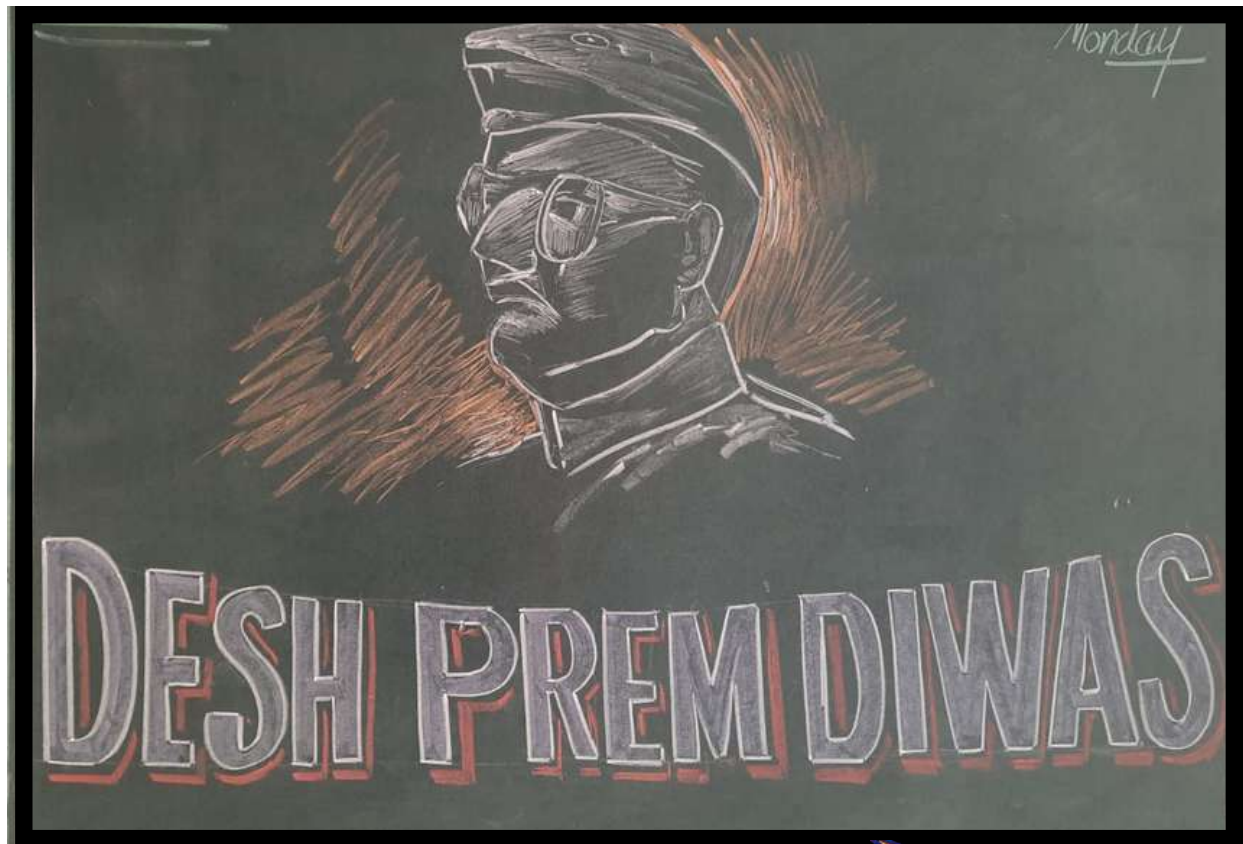


22nd January : Desh Prem Diwas

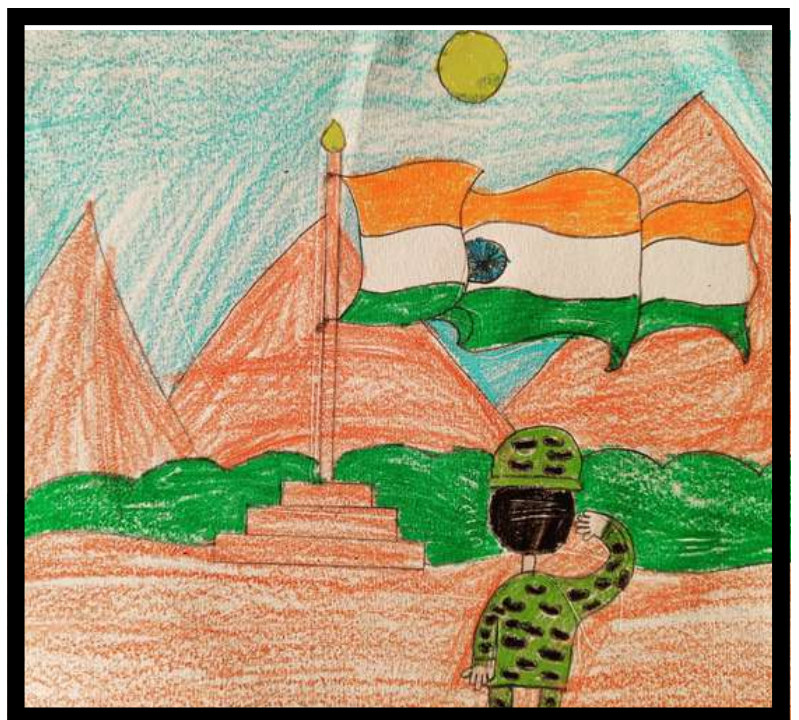

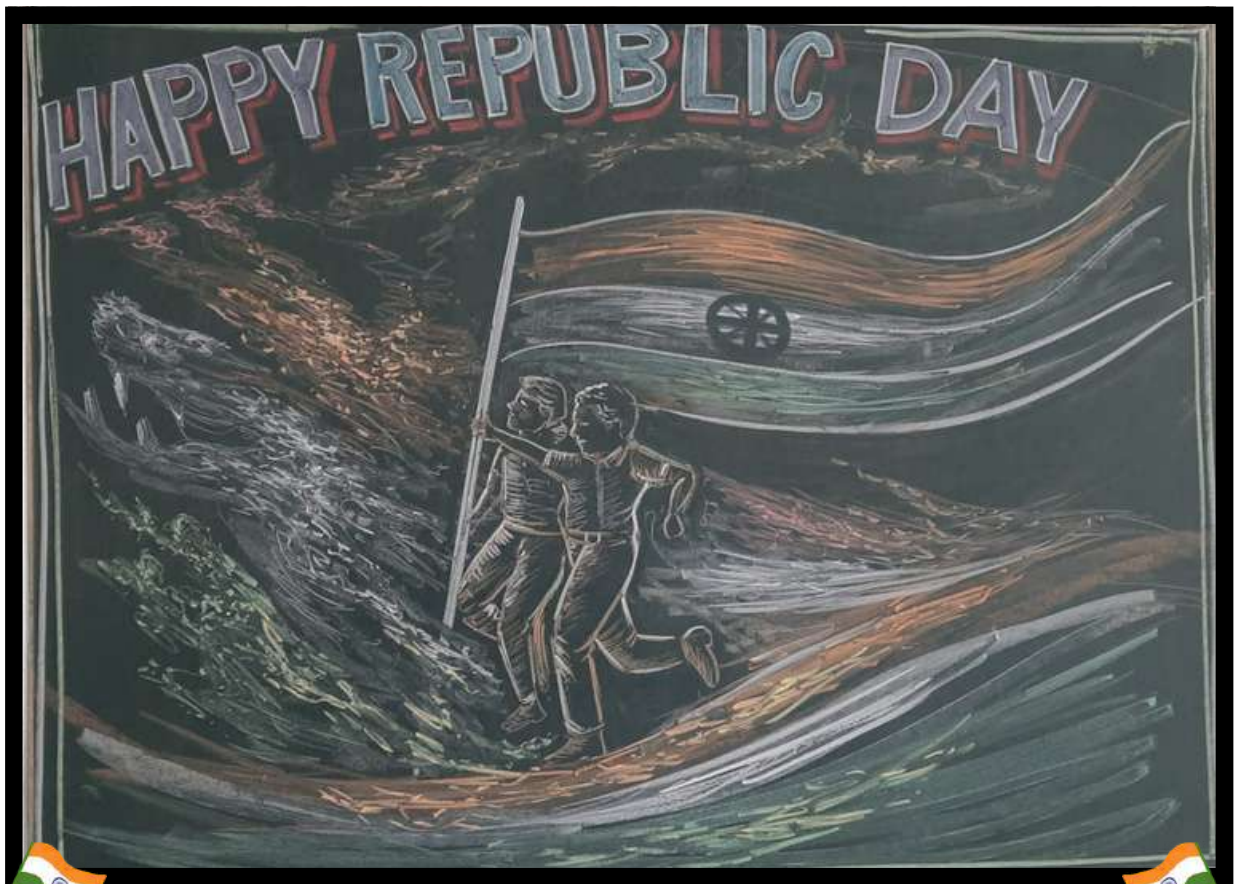
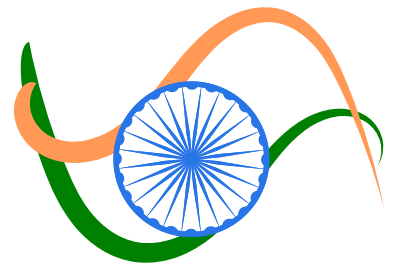
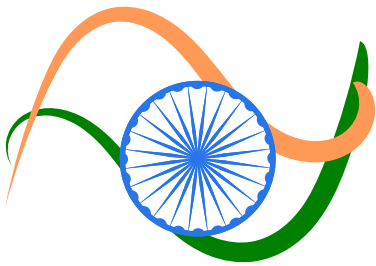




26th January : Republic Day
