Each day of the week was dedicated to one key 21st Century Skill such as IPR, Creativity, Digital Skills, Gaming, IoT and electronics, Mobile app development, Astronomy and many more. Atal Innovation Mission and Spark Astronomy organised astronomy lectures for ATL students and teachers. It was a set of 7 series of lectures which took the participants to a journey of exploration of the universe and gave an understanding of origin and evolution of the universe and the future of space exploration.

BRICS MATH- International Competition (19 October, 2020 - 20 December, 2020)

Codeavour, 2020 AI/ Webinar for GPPS

Codeavour 2020 AI is an international online AI and coding competition for students. Codeavour is hosted by STEMPedia annually to encourage kids across the globe to bring out their inner coder & make innovative projects using PictoBlox – widely-acclaimed AI-enabled graphical coding platform.

With the future belonging to fast-rising technologies such as artificial intelligence (speech recognition, face recognition, text recognition, and the like) and coding, it is important for students today to be proficient in them. Codeavour 2020 AI aims to motivate them to develop an interest in these technologies and prepare them for an AI-future.

Our school partnered with Codeavour 2020 AI. Many students from our esteemed organisation, GPPS, attended the online webinars which were organised by STEMPedia between 2 October, 2020 and 5 January, 2021. The aim of these webinars was to introduce the students to the concepts of block-based programming, game design, artificial intelligence and machine learning.

AIM Innovation Program 3.0

Educational Foundation "Talent and Success" (Sirius, Russia) and Atal Innovation Mission (NITI Aayog, India) have organised a 14-day virtual educational learning, innovation program for selected students from India and Russia. The program is focused on Developing Technological Solutions (Web-based and Mobile Applications) for the key Grassroot Problems linked with the big challenges of both nations. The educational program and Hackathon are designed to develop students' competencies in understanding 21st-century technologies and developing innovative engineering and technological projects to meet the challenges of sustainable development.

ATL Student App Innovation Challenge, 2020

BRICSMATH+ Competition for Classes 1 to 12 class students (16 Nov-20 Nov, 2020)

BRICSMATH+ is the 4th International Online Mathematics Competition for students from classes I to XII. 139 students took part in the competition. 21 students received achievement certificates and rest of the students received participation certificates.

Climate Change Challenge

The Climate Change Challenge was organised by CSIR-Centre for Cellular and Molecular Biology (Hyderabad) under its Jigyasa Program for schools to create climate change solutions in their local surroundings.

The objectives of the challenge is to create local champions for climate change who can advocate for a more sustainable life through art, educate people about climate change through innovative games, understand the problems that arise due to climate change through research, and develop solutions through technology.

Young Scientist India – Innovation Competition - 15 December 2020

‘Young Scientist India’ – the Innovation Competition is a novel idea to promote scientific temperament among high school students, to increase their understanding of science and to attract them into scientific careers.

Many students from Classes VI-VIII participated in this competition.

India’s Future Tycoons (IFT) - Season 3

IFT is the national platform for young adults to showcase their ideas and build ventures. It works with youth across India to develop an entrepreneurial mindset, encouraging them to think about problems around them and take steps to create sustainable ventures. Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) is the ‘Knowledge Partner’ of India’s Future Tycoons (IFT) Season 3. The theme of the season was ‘Education Redefined’. It aims at getting brilliant ideas from students on how to reimagine education in the new normal-identifying problems in the current education system, converting them into opportunities and building innovative solutions to solve them.

Students of our school always show their eagerness for such activities and many of them sent their creative ideas for further consideration.

National All Rounder Championship

National All Rounder Championship was organised by KidEx from 1 December to 15 December.
