

On the basis of the sessions, a small quiz was taken up by the student in-order to receive a certificate.

The link for the quiz was provided in the chat section during the workshop.




An introduction to the ATL, by ATL Convener, Golaya Progressive Public School –






and Etiquettes of Speech. This session, definitely, honed-up the communication skills of students.





After the session by Ms. Ashima, two of our students took the initiative to share their views related to their all-over enhancement, being associated with ATL.

To begin with, Miss. Harshita of IX-C:-




Next, Came Ananya Sharma, IX-A, who began by briefing about her experience in ATL and concluded with showcasing one of her AI projects:-




After this, representing the journey of ATL students, a small video showcasing the projects of ATL students was set to display-
