Earth Day











Summer Camp








Save Dolphins, Save Oceans

Independence Day







Janmashtami






Paper Bag Activity







Fine motor skills are important for doing routine tasks independently.












Art & Craft

The rally ended with a collective pledge to reduce, reuse, and refuse plastic for a cleaner and greener Earth.












Handwashing Awareness Rally
