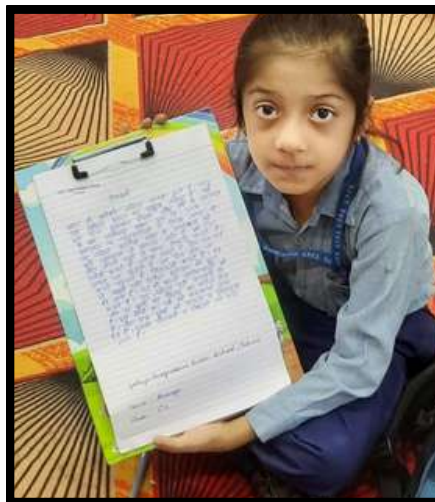




# BAL BHAWAN ACTIVITIES

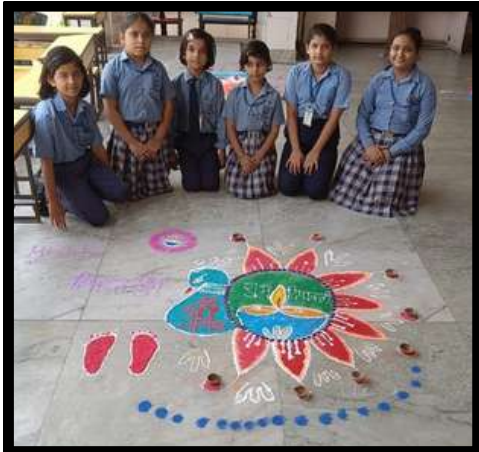

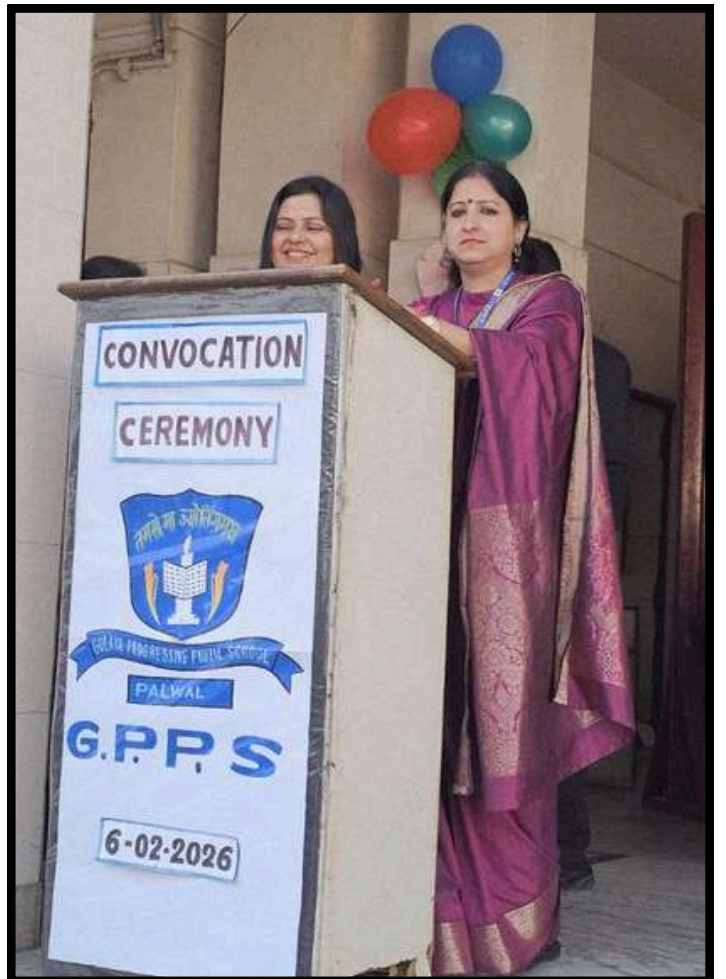
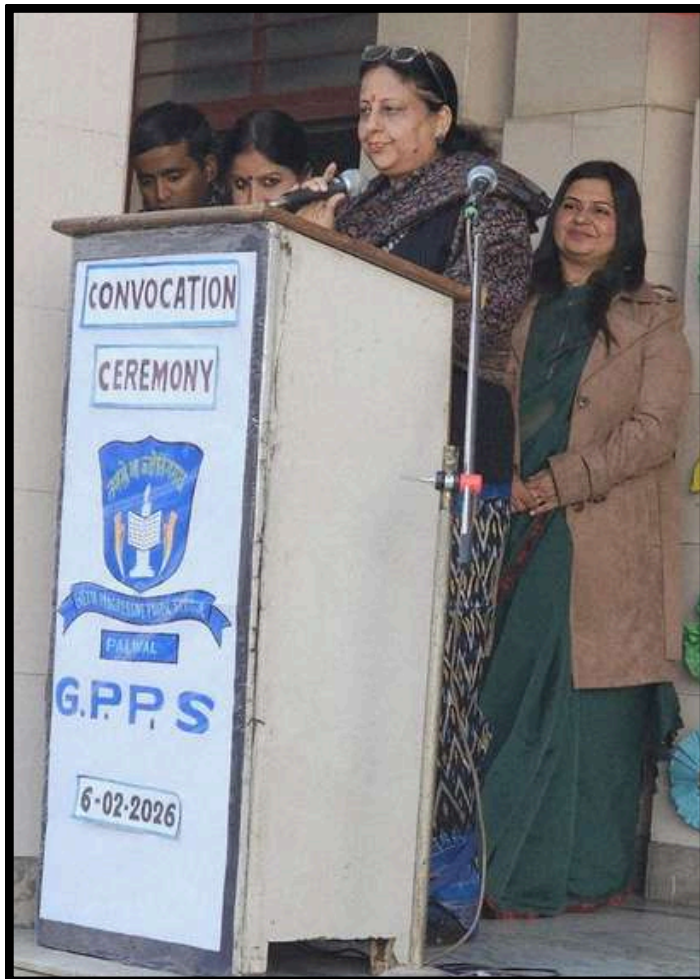
# CONVOCAATION CEREMONY

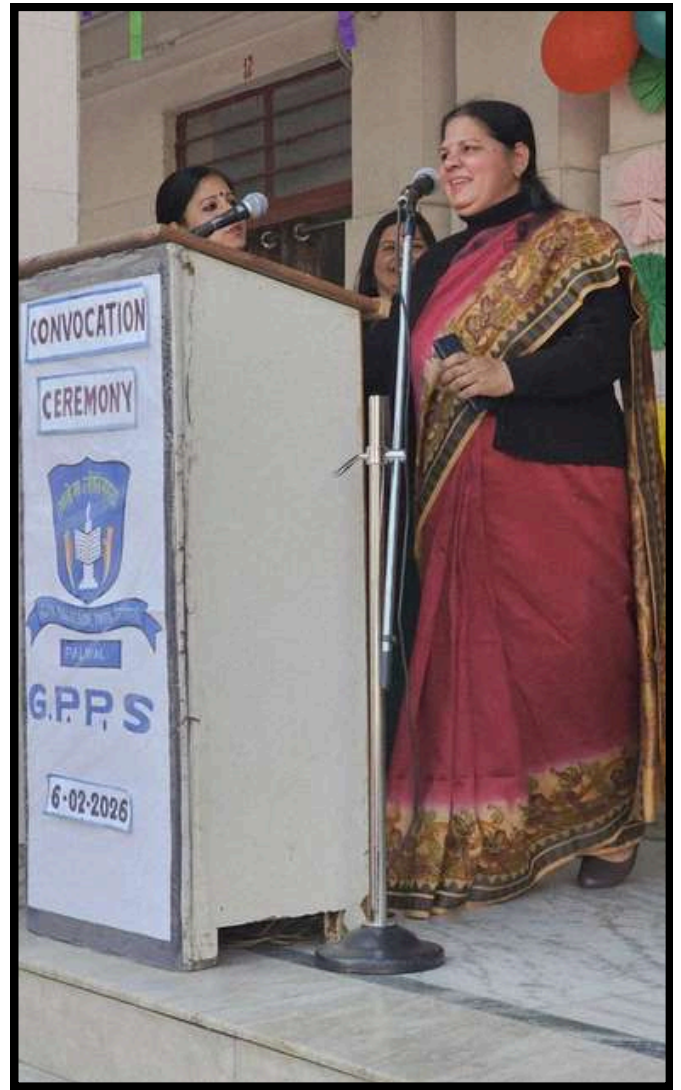

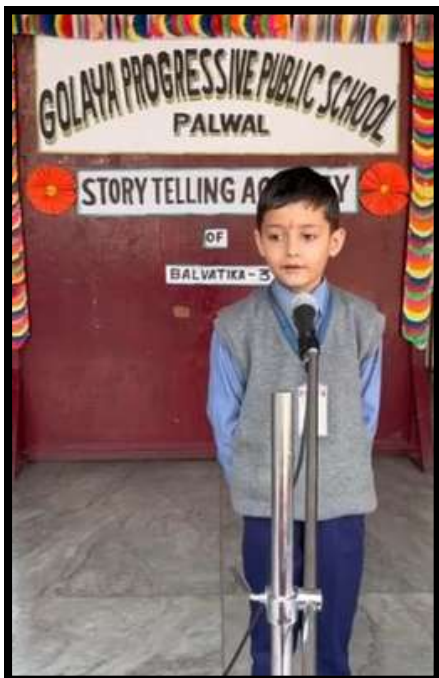


# STORY TELLING ACTIVITY
