The new academic session 2021-22 commenced from 1 April as per the directives of CBSE. The start of the academic year seemed more overwhelming than ever before. The first two weeks were utilised for identifying learning gaps that formed during the session 2020-21 which were addressed by having a bridge course specially designed to address these gaps.






WORLD MIGRATORY BIRD DAY - 12 MAY 2021


BAL BHAWAN SUMMER CAMP - 2021







Yoga means addition – addition of energy, strength and beauty to body, mind and soul.


















