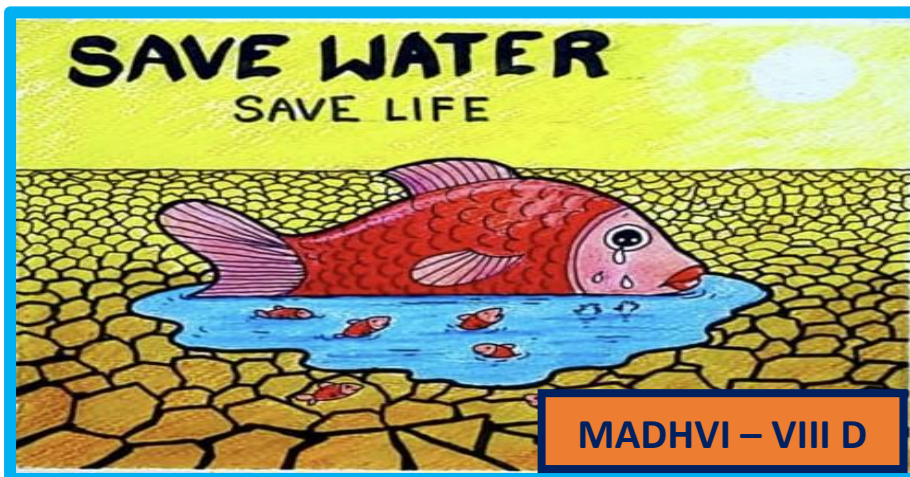




WORLD NATURE CONSERVATION DAY – 27 JULY 2021

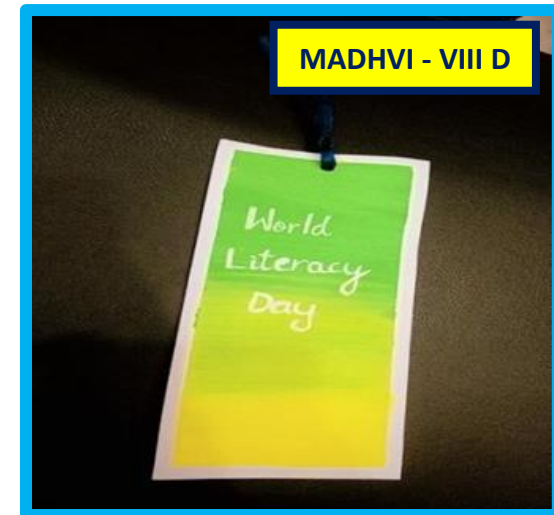
INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY – 8 SEP 2021

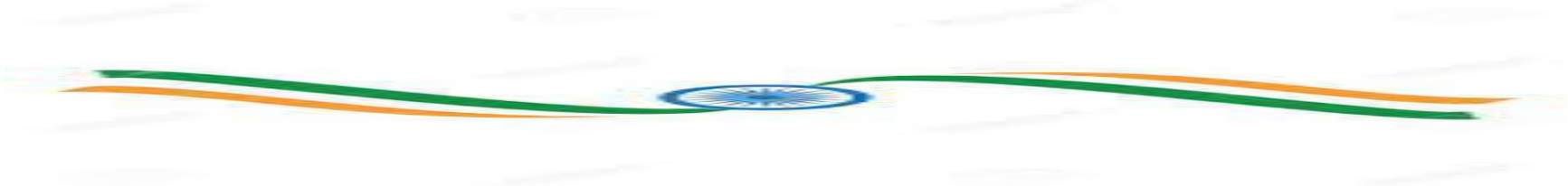

ATL CORNER

ATL or ‘Atal Tinkering Lab’ is an initiative by the NITI Aayog to boost the innovation ecosystem in the country. The aim is to empower youth with the 21st-century skills of creativity, critical thinking, design thinking, social and cross-cultural collaboration, ethical leadership etc. It provides activity-based learning in different schools across the country where young minds can give shape to their ideas to deal with existing societal problems. It also fosters entrepreneurship and innovation, enabling over 3 million students between Grade VI to Grade XII to acquire a problem solving, tinkering and innovative mindset.

Community Day - 14 April 2021 - 16 April 2021

ATLs across India celebrate Community Day on 14th April to commemorate Dr. B.R. Ambedkar on his birth anniversary and to stay true to his philosophy of providing an equal opportunity to all and thereby creating an inclusive society of young innovators. The ATL Community Day aims to introduce children who don't have access to formal education to the philosophy of Atal Tinkering Labs and thereby to innovation. In the previous years we saw ATLs across India opening up their gates to children from nearby non - ATL schools, NGOs, social welfare organizations and local communities to celebrate a fun filled day in open sessions on tinkering and innovation.

This year since most schools were unable to conduct Community Day within their school premises, Atal Innovation Mission organized a 3 - day event from 14 -16 April which included live sessions, motivational talks and fun filled activities for all students across the country as well as for their parents and teachers. Many students participated in these events. Ananya Sharma, Harshit and Harshita Tanwar of Class X and Sagar of Class XII got certificates for excellent leadership.

Tinkerpreneur

Tinkerpreneur was the theme for ATL Tinker Fest this year. It was a 2-month long summer bootcamp which equipped each student with key digital skills and frameworks to create their own online venture by the end of the bootcamp.

The bootcamp aimed to leverage the knowledge and hands-on involvement of ATL Mentors of Change and combined it with insights from industry leaders to provide students with a thorough introduction to entrepreneurship.

Students mapped to their mentors of change and had access to a repository of digital skills, DIY content and simple assignments to enable them to create their own digital product. 3 students had attended the summer bootcamp.

WCF - ATL CyberSmart Training Program

Atal Innovation Mission has partnered with WNS Cares Foundation (WCF), the CSR arm of WNS (a leading BPM Company) to empower children with knowledge on relevant topics around cyber safety through its platform, CyberSmart.
